The 2016-2017 Reflections program has completed judging and the advancing artists have been selected. I would like to thank all the volunteers to assisted me during the Reflections Drop off.

In total 78 units participated in this year's Reflection program, submitting in total 506 pieces of student artwork. The artwork categories resulted in the following:

Per the numbers above, similar to last year, visual arts is the most popular category and there was an increase in the number of 3D artwork pieces submitted.
