 March Report

In total 78 units participated in this year’s Reflection program, submitting in total 506 pieces of student artwork. The artwork categories resulted in the following:

Per the numbers above, similar to last year, visual arts is the most popular category and there was an increase in the number of 3D artwork pieces submitted.
