Detective Mosby from the Hate Crimes Unit spoke of 20 possible hate crimes reported which developed into 1 actual hate crime and 3 actual hate incidents being investigated. These included biases regarding to anti-Semitic, anti-Asian and anti-Black issues.

Our guest speaker was Terryl Dozier who spoke of “The People’s Plan”, a plan for “Reimagining Policing & Public Safety on Long Island”. It was a collaboration of local groups including Long Island Advocates for Police Accountability (LIAFPA), Long Island United to Transform Policing & Community Safety (LI United), United for Justice In Policing Long Island (UJPLI). Additional key contributors were Gender Equality New York (GENY), Long Island Language Advocates Coalition (LILAC) and New York Social Action (NYSA).
